#### DAY 02 - Wednesday 16 October: Istanbul

Turkey is truly where East meets West and it is precisely this mixture that makes travel in Turkey so interesting. Although its culture has a respect for Islam, Turkey is a country that attempts to separate the secular and religious beliefs of its citizens. Istanbul is one of the world's most interesting cities. Its unique location, literally bridging the gap between 'East" and "West", and unique history as a Christian and then Islamic city, is precisely what attracts tourist to the shores of the Asian Continent. We begin the tour with our first stop at the Basilica of Hagia Sophia (Cathedral of Holy Wisdom); it is unquestionably one of the finest buildings of all time. Built by Constantine the Great, it was reconstructed by Justinian in the 6th Century. Following this we visit the Grand Bazaar; it has been in operation since the 14th Century. The Grand Bazaar is one of the world's largest covered markets, with 58 streets and over 4,000 shops. It is especially known for its jewellery, leather, pottery, spices and carpets. It's been a long exciting day so as we make our way back to the Venera Hotel for dinner, after which we will meet for a short briefing of the days ahead















DAY 03 - Thursday 17 October: Izmir - Pergamum

After breakfast we will transfer to the airport for our Pegasus Airlines flight to **Izmir** departing at 09:10. Upon arrival we drive to the hauntingly beautiful **Pergamum**. Among the impressive structures of this city, dating from 399 BC., we will see the Altar of Zeus, Temple of Dionysus and the 200,000 volume library which was surpassed only by that found in Alexandria at the time. The Asclepieum of **Pergamum** was a famous health centre where methods of treatment included blood transfusions, music therapy and meditation. Thereafter, we proceed to Izmir.

#### DAY 04 - Friday 18 October: Smyrna - Sardis - Philadelphia

After breakfast we visit the Church of **Smyrna**. Then drive to **Pamukkale**. We will stop by **Thyatira** to see the remains of the church. This was one of the principle towns where Christianity spread quickly. Then we will drive to **Sardis** whose history dates back to 12th century B.C. Sardis felt the influence of Christianity very early and was included in the **Seven Churches of the Apocalypse**. During the Byzantine times it was the seat of a bishopric. Highlights will be a Synagogue, Gymnasium, Byzantine Church and the Temple of Artemis. Next on our itinerary is **Philadelphia** which was an important Christian centre during Byzantine times. We will see the Basilica and several interesting mosques.

#### DAY 05 - Saturday 19 October: Hierapolis - Laodicea

In the morning we visit **Hierapolis**, which was founded by Pergamum King Telephons and named after his wife, Hiera. During the Byzantine period, the city became the seat of diocese with a large Christian Church dedicated to **Philip**, who was martyred there in 80 AD. Highlights include the Roman Baths, the Theatre and the famous white calcium cascades of Pamukkale (**the white "Cotton Castles"**). Then we will visit **Laodicea**, where we will find a Theatre, a large Stadium, a Water Tower and an Odeon. This city is supposed to have been named by Antiochus II in honour of his wife, Laodicea.



#### DAY 06 - Sunday 20 October: Isle of Patmos

The Book of Revelation was revealed to the Apostle John on an island called Patmos. He was banished there for his testimony of Jesus. After an early breakfast, we will also sail to the Isle of Patmos as we transfer to the port for our chartered boat which will take 3 hours. Likewise John was shipped to Patmos against his will and as a result of a decision made by unbelieving governmental authorities. They sent him there to 'teach him a lesson'. We would not have had the Book of Revelation if God did not somehow work a way to get John off that desolate prison colony. Once we arrive we will proceed to visit the Monastery of St. John and the Grotto. We will have plenty of time to wander and enjoy this place that gave us the Book of Revelation. Lunch will be at your leisure on the Isle of Patmos and we trust the sun will be kind to us also. You will have some time here to roam or ponder the moments when John received the vision of Revelation. There is no rushing at this amazing place. Later in the afternoon we will make our way to the port to return to Kusadasi.

#### DAY 07 - Monday 21 October: Ephesus

Then drive to **Selcuk** town, we will visit the famous ancient city of **Ephesus**, one of the world's finest archaeological sites. Our tour will begin with the **Basilica of St John** "the Evangelist" who came here with the Virgin Mary and wrote his Gospel in Ephesus. Highlights include the **Library of Celcius**, the **Temple of Hadrian**, the **Fountain of Trajan** and the **Theatre** if time permits. However, Ephesus' greatest claim to fame was its temple to the goddess Artemis. One of the **'seven wonders'** of the ancient world, it was almost four times larger than the Parthenon in Athens. According to the New Testament, the Apostle Paul preached in Ephesus, prompting a riot led by silversmiths who crafted shrines to the goddess and feared for both their livelihoods and the future of the temple. In **Ephesus** you will stand in front of the theatre where **Paul** preached, able to seat 25,000, imagine the commotion he made. Then in the distance you will see the hilltop where they imprisoned him. It's amazing that the temple has been so utterly destroyed that only one lonely pillar remains, all its grandeur lays waste amongst the weeds that cover its foundation.


#### DAY 08 - Tuesday 22 October: Istanbul


Today will be a long but exciting day, so be prepared for it. After an early breakfast transfer to Izmir Airport for our 7 AM flight back to Istanbul on Pegasus Airlines. Once we arrive we will board our bus which will then take us to Istanbul's 'Old City'. Our first stop is the Hippodrome of Constantinople, the centre of Byzantine civic life, where horse and chariot races once took place. Take a moment and listen to bygone sounds of pounding hoofs, or the shouts of bystanders as horse and chariot pounded the ground in pursuit of an elusive trophy. We then make our way to the infamous Blue Mosque, known for the impressive blue tiles lining its inner walls. By now you may feel the rumblings of hunger and so we will make out way to a nearby café for lunch. In the afternoon, we visit the famous Topkapi Palace, it is an amazing place, and the jewellery alone is stunning. This was once the, home to the Turkish Ottoman sultans between the 15th and 19th centuries. It is now a museum exhibiting imperial collections of crystal, silver, Chinese porcelain and imperial costumes. The final stop on our last day in Turkey is the Spice Bazaar. Here you can find beautiful hand painted plates, or the purest cooking spices, where the smell of cinnamon, cloves and thyme rise from hundreds of colourful muslin bags on every store-front. The Spice Bazaar is not as big as the Grand Bazaar but it is an experience in itself. Since we have plenty of time we can make our way to a Turkish restaurant for dinner after which we will travel to Istanbul's SAW airport for our Pegasus Airlines flight to Tel Aviv arriving at about 10:30pm.

#### DAY 09 - Wednesday 23 October: Sea of Galilee

Good morning everyone, it's a wonderful day to be in the Galilee. We trust you have woken refreshed and ready to go. As Isaiah prophesied that the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light (Isaiah 9: 1). God's Word will shine even more brightly for us as we explore 'His territory.' This begins with a memorable boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Time will be given to reflect on the Lord's lakeside ministry while floating on the lake. On shore again, we visit Jesus' city of Capernaum with the ruins of Peter's motherin-law's house and the ancient synagogue. Relive the immortal 'Sermon on the Mount' (Matthew 5-7) on the Mount of Beatitudes. We will drive by Kursi, where the legion entered the swine that were grazing on the hill, when suddenly they ran down the slope and into the lake. Today we will enjoy a wonderful meal by the lake of the most famous St Peter's fish. Our final stop for the day is at Yardenit: located on the southern edge of the lake. This is the place of baptism for those who want to be baptised by full immersion.

#### Day 10: Thursday 24 October : Galilee – Golan Heights

At Mitzpe Shalom in the magnificent southern Golan Heights, at the edge of a basalt precipice overlooking a breathtaking panoramic landscape of the Sea of Galilee, Mount Hermon, the Galilee Mountains, the peak of Mount Tabor and the fields of the Jordan Valley. We head to Mount Bental. It is a worthwhile side trip to the top of Mount Bental for the views alone. After all, this inactive volcano delivers great views of Lebanon, Israel, and Syria which is just a stone's throw away, also Mount Hermon, Mount Avital and the Syrian town of Quneitra. However, ascending Mount Bental will also provide one with a keener appreciation of the strategic significance of the Golan Heights. And as if that were not enough, it also serves as a splendid overlook for a number of sites of historical significance. Unsurprisingly, the commanding views from atop Mount Bental did not go unnoticed by either the Syrian or Israeli military as the many abandoned bunkers and trenches in the area will attest to.


From here we continue north we will drive by the area where the demons entered the swine and they ran down the hill into the lake, this is called Kursi. Then we go to Dan, a city mentioned in the Bible and described as the northern most city of the Kingdom of Israel, belonging to the Tribe of Dan. It was here that an altar was built to house the golden calf and where Baal was worshipped. If time permits we will inspect an old Crusader castle known as Nimrod's Castle. It's a bit of a fun time to explore and imagine life way back then.

#### Day 11: Friday 25 October: To Jerusalem

Today we leave the gracious shores of the **Sea of Galilee** behind and begin our long ascent to **Jerusalem**. Our tour commences in **Nazareth**. We ascend the heights of **Mount Precipice** where we view the **Valley of Armageddon**. Its beauty will take your breath away. It's hard to imagine such a beautiful area will one day be the gathering place of armies according to Revelation. From here we will visit a reconstructed **Nazareth Village** which will show us what Jesus' town may have looked like when he lived there. If time permits we will visit **Muhraka**, where we relive with **Elijah** those wonderful moments when the LORD answered by fire and proved He is God (I Kings 18:39). Our final stop before heading to **Jerusalem/Bethlehem** is where we visit the impressive remains of the Roman capital of **Israel**, namely **Caesarea Maritima**, built like a mini-Rome on the **Plain of Sharon**. Though it was thoroughly pagan, Caesarea has the glorious distinction of being the place where the **Gentiles** were first born again and filled with the **Holy Spirit**.

Day 12: Saturday 26 October: Bethlehem - Jerusalem

First thing this morning after breakfast we make our way to **Bethlehem's Church of Nativity**; the birthplace of **Jesus**. This church is 1500 years old, its interior has been battered and bruised by armies and thieves but it has stood the test of time. We will enter the church through a door that over time has been reduced in size; we will descend 14 stairs into the grotto cave where his birth took place. From here if time permits we will drive by the area where it is believed the **Shepherd's Field** is located and finally stop for some shopping. After lunch will drive through the border control and head to Jerusalem's new city to visit the **Yad Va Shem Holocaust Museum**: It is more than a museum; it is an institution which tells the story of the near destruction of European Jewry during the horrors of the Nazi holocaust of the Second World War. It is a place you will never forget. We will then check into our hotel for the next 3-nights, followed by a free afternoon to wander the streets of **Jerusalem** to shop or hang out at a local cafe, or just relaxing by the hotel pool.

#### Day 13: Sunday 27 October: Old City of Jerusalem

Our first stop, if conditions permit, is the **Temple Mount**, also known as the **Haram el Sharif** (Arabic: Noble Sanctuary). It is built on **Mount Moriah**, where **Abraham** conducted the near-sacrifice of his son Isaac (Genesis 22). These 14 hectares of sacred space is the most priceless piece of real estate in the world. Here is the location of the temples of **Solomon** and **Herod**; the latter is where the infant Jesus was presented before the Lord by Mary and Joseph. As a man He taught in the temple courts and overturned the money changers' tables. Since the 7th Century AD, the mount has housed the twin shrines of the **Dome of the Rock** and the **al Aqsa Mosque**, among the most sacred of Muslim shrines. We then visit the **Western Wall**, once a purely religious site, today it is a national shrine and community centre where people pray, soldiers are inducted, and young men have their bar mitzvahs. Nearby is the **Davidson Centre**, where we can see impressive remains of the **New Testament** period, including the **Temple Steps**. From here we visit the **City of David**, the original **Jerusalem**, which was once he Jebusite city captured by David and converted into his capital and God's holy city. Finally we will take a walk together through the watery tunnel built by **Hezekiah**; it's an experience not to be missed.

Day 14: Monday 28 October: Triumphal Entry

Come experience the magnificent panorama of Jerusalem from the **Mount of Olives**, where Jesus ascended to heaven and where He will return one day. We will relieve some of the most poignant moments in the **New Testament**. Walking down the **Palm Sunday Road**, we stop by **Dominus Flevit**, the 'tear drop church where Jesus wept over the city of Jerusalem and foretold the tragic events that would happen because it refused to recognize its time of visitation. Going further down into the Valley of Jehoshaphat, we visit the **Church of All Nations**, which houses the **Garden of Gethsemane**. **'Gethsemane'** means 'oil press,' and here, Jesus the Messiah/Anointed One/Christ, began His passion. His betrayal by Judas Iscariot and arrest occurred here. Gethsemane never fails to move pilgrims to tears. Nearby is the sealed **Golden Gate**, where Christ entered the temple precincts during His triumphal entry. We enter the **Old City of Jerusalem** at **St. Stephen's Gate**, named for Stephen the first Christian martyr, who was stoned near here. We stop off at the **Pool of Bethesda**, where Jesus healed the paralytic of 38 years (John 5:1-15). Bethesda means 'house of mercy.' We continue down the Via Dolorosa (way of sorrows), traditional route where Jesus carried the cross to **Calvary**. There are 14 Stations of the Cross, the last five meet in the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, Christendom's most sacred shrine, which houses the traditional site of **Calvary** and the **Tomb of Christ**. **Mount Zion** is considered the 'dwelling place of God.' Of interest is that it is next door to **Gehenna**, the prototype of hell.





We visit the **Upper Room**, traditional location of the Last Supper where the believers waited or the Holy Spirit to come. Nearby, we visit the impressive **St. Peter-in-Gallicantu** Church, location of the place of the High Priest Caiaphas. It was here that Jesus stood trial before the Sanhedrin and where Peter denied Jesus three times The final stop for today is the **Garden Tomb**, this is the only evangelical site in the whole city, the garden setting gives us a glance of what the tomb of Jesus may have looked like, it is here we will share communion together as we remember His resurrection from the dead.

#### Day 15: Wednesday 29 October: Dead Sea Region

We say good-bye to **Jerusalem** and begin today's adventure by visiting the hilltop fortress of **Masada**, today is one of the Jewish people's greatest symbols. Israeli soldiers take an oath here: Masada shall not fall again. Next to Jerusalem, it is the most popular destination of Jewish tourists visiting Israel. When the great revolt of AD 70 ended, the surviving Zealots fled Jerusalem to Masada near the Dead Sea. There, they held out for three years. Anyone who has climbed the famous "snake path" to Masada can understand why the surrounding Roman troops had to a step ascent to the top. Masada is situated on top of an enormous, isolated rock: Anyone climbing it to attack the fortress would be an easy target. Yet the Jews, encamped in the fortress, could never feel secure; every morning they woke to see the Roman Legion hard at work constructing a siege ramp.. Once the Romans breached the walls and entered the fortress, they discovered the 960 Jewish defenders had committed mass suicide, rather than surrender. You can read the complete account in the writings of **Josephus**. We will then drive by **Qumran**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were discovered. Next is a well-deserved rest stop at **Kalia Beach**, where you will have the opportunity to float on the **Dead Sea**. It's a great time to relax and apply a mud mask to your body. Our final stop is the world's oldest city **Jericho**, where we visit **Tel Jericho** and view the **Mount of Temptation**

## Queen of Sheba 4-Day Extension


#### Day 16: Thursday 30 October: En Gedi - Beersheba

The Queen of Sheba extension begins as we travel along the Rift Valley south to En Gedi. This is where David cut the corner of King Saul's robe off as he slept in a cave. We will hike a short distance to this amazing oasis when fresh water flows from the rocks and waterfall cascades into the pool below. Next we head to Beersheba to see the Well of Abraham and a stop off at the WW1 Australian Light Horseman's Cemetery, it was Australians who help take Beersheba from the Ottomans in 1917.

If time permits we will visit the home of **David Ben Gurion** at Sde Boker before heading further south to **Avdat**. The ruins of Avdat, the greatest *Nabatean* city in the Negev, lie on a limestone hill overlooking the desert. The remains include two impressive *Byzantine* churches, a wine press, and many other interesting finds. We will also visit Israel's version of the Grand Canyon called **Ramon Crater** the largest of the three Negev craters. It contains geological formations unparalleled elsewhere in the world, along with a magnificent panorama. The Ramon Nature Reserve encompassing the crater and the Negev Mountains surrounding it is the largest nature reserve in Israel. We will stop at **Timna** and see the life size model of **Moses' Tabernacle**; you will get some amazing insight that will enlighten you to the Old Testament. After a day in the desert you deserve a well-earned treat as we make the Red Sea our final stop for the day. After settling in to our hotel and enjoyed a wonderful dinner together you can make your way to the boardwalk and check out the market that lines the boardwalk. The shops close at 11pm, so there is plenty of time to explore.

Day 18: Sunday 2 November: Petra

Petra is our sole focal point today, its name stems from the Greek meaning 'stone'. Once we arrive you can opt to ride a horse to the entry of the Siq, followed by a 1.6 kilometre walk. Deep in the desert lays the ancient city of Petra; ruined cities in remote places have always stirred the human imagination and Petra will not let you down. Through a narrow gorge it emerges into view, revealing awe-inspiring monuments cut into the surrounding cliffs, it's an astonishing place. The Nabataeans erected Al Khazneh also known as The Treasury, its monumental tombs, memorializing their kings and leaders. But over time political control changed, and so did trade routes. Eventually the city fell silent, forgotten by the outside world. But in 1812 Petra was to be rediscovered as the red city as it rose from its sandy sleep, but not to its former glory but that of a shell of its former past. Excavations have demonstrated that the Nabataeans controlled their water supply that led to the rise of the desert city, creating an artificial oasis. Some scholars believe that Petra is the place in the wilderness where 'the woman' flees from 'the dragon' (Revelation 12:6). It could very well be the last refuge, like a latter day Masada, for those who flee from Jerusalem (Zechariah 14). As you enjoy Petra, the pertinent prophetic Scriptures will take on new meaning.
