** We recommend those coming from Australia fly via Dubai on Emirates EK903 arriving in Amman at 4:30 pm.

If you would like to arrive in Amman a day or two early to help adjust to jet lag we can help with booking your accommodation at the hotel. This will help you rest and adjust before the start of the tour.

13 November Day 1: Arrival

Today you will all be arriving in Amman, Jordan! Those arriving on the main flight (the flight with the most amount of people) will be met by us at the airport and transferred to the hotel. Whatever time you arrive in Amman, the rest of the day is free until dinner when the tour officially starts.

If you arrive at a different time/on a different flight to main group, you will need to make your own way to the hotel. After dinner, we will meet together briefly before returning to your rooms for a good night's sleep in anticipation of the adventure ahead.

Overnight: Olive Tree Hotel, Amman. Included Meals: Dinner

14 November Day 2: Petra

An early start will take us south through the desert to the red city of Petra built on the cliffs of Edom. We begin at the Siq; you can choose to go on foot or go on horseback. As we make our way through the narrow Siq; suddenly the rocks open up to reveal the magnificent Al Khazneh; known as one of the seven wonders of the world! Just try to grasp the fact that the Nabateans, more than 2000 years ago, carved this 45-meter-high Treasury monument into the red mountain rock.

We will spend the entire day exploring as many wonders as possible before the sun begins to set.

Overnight: Petra Guest House, Petra. Included Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

15 November

Day 3: Desert Safari II Moses Tabernacle

This morning we make our way to the Arava's southern border crossing between Jordan and Israel. We enter Israel via Eilat, located on the edge of the Red Sea. We will ascend through the wadi along Nahal Solomon, Rehoboam Nahal, and Jehoshaphat Nahal up 725 meters above sea level on the way to Mount Joash. At a few stopping points, your guide will share stories about the history of the area. We will stop for a picnic of pita bread with local labneh cheese and a cup of herbal tea, before continuing. From this observation point, you'll be able to see four countries, Israel, Egypt, Saudi Arabia, and Jordan.

After lunch, it is a short drive to the historic connection between Timna Park to a replica of Moses' Tabernacle. Timna provides the perfect desert backdrop to display this fascinating replica, built in a complete, accurate, and authentic reconstruction of the appearance of the 'Mishkan', used by the people of Israel, in the wilderness.

Finally, we head to Jericho for the night.

16 November Day 4: Masada II En Gedi

Masada is a fortress built by Herod who was a master builder, his imprint can be seen all over Israel today. Masada is a rugged natural fortress, of majestic beauty, in the Judaean Desert overlooking the Dead Sea. It is a symbol of the ancient kingdom of Israel, its violent destruction, and the last stand of Jewish patriots in the face of the Roman army, in 73 A.D. It was built as a palace complex, in the classic style of the early Roman Empire, by Herod the Great, King of Judaea, (reigned 37 – 4 B.C.). The camps, fortifications, and attack ramp that encircle the monument constitute the most complete Roman siege works surviving to the present day.

From here, we continue north to En Gedi where David hid from Saul in the wilderness oasis. The specific location where Saul searched for David was called "The Crags of the Wild Goats," because of the rocky terrain of En Gedi (1 Samuel 24:2). Climb the cliffs to the waterfall and experience the wilderness like David, walk the narrow paths of the Ibex and dip your feet in the cool refreshing natural pools. We then return to Jericho for the night.

17 November Day 5: Jericho II Mt Temptation II Qumran II Dead Sea

Today we take another cable car up to the Mount of Temptation and view the Jordan Valley below. We will see what Jesus saw when He was tempted by the devil and offered everything as far as the eye could see. We will stop at the old Sycamore Tree and imagine Zacchaeus sitting on its branches peering over the crowds to see Jesus.

Next, we head to Qumran for lunch and to view the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found by a young shepherd boy. It was this discovery that led to more and more discoveries resulting in a total of 929 texts – scrolls housed in jars inside the caves – known collectively as the Dead Sea Scrolls. Finally, a well-deserved float on the Dead Sea before returning to our hotel.

18 November

Day 6: Boat Ride II Mt of Beatitudes II Capernaum II Baptism

Today we head north to the Sea of Galilee - the most famous body of water in the world! This is where Jesus' ministry was based, specifically at Capernaum. The Mount of Beatitudes is where Jesus gave the Sermon on the Mount and fed thousands on bread & fish. Capernaum, right on the lake, is where Peter's mother-in-law lived. We will see many ruins from bygone years. We will experience a boat ride on the lake and enjoy Messianic worship.

Finally, we will take a short drive to the Jordan River where you can be baptized in the clear waters filled with fish; we might even see an Otter floating by. Today we will enjoy a Saint Peter's Fish lunch, right by the lake.

19 November

Day 7: Mt Carmel Assembly II Nazareth Village II Mt Precipice II Mukhraka II Arbel

This morning we will visit the Mount Carmel Assembly, and experience Messianic praise and worship with some of the local believers. We will take a love offering for the congregation so come prepared.

Our next stop is the Nazareth Village, a must-see! Here we will see and experience what life was like in the time, and home village of Jesus. You will see how people lived, and how they made their food, tools, and clothing.

Following this, we will visit Mt Precipice, which overlooks the Valley of Armageddon. This is known as the Gathering Place for the armies that will fight against the Lord. Nearby is Mukhraka where Elijah called fire from heaven, it is here that many armies were defeated in the past and they will again be defeated in the future. On our return to Tiberias, we hope to stop at Mt Arbel and view the Sea of Galilee from above in all its beauty, the lake is harp-shaped resting deep in the valley surrounded by Galilee Mountains.

The rest of the day is free until dinner, so enjoy a walk through this little lakeside town of Tiberias, follow the boardwalk along its edges, maybe stop for ice cream or visit the local market.

20 November

Day 8: Caesarea II Ancient Aqueduct

Today we say goodbye to Galilee and make our way west to the Mediterranean coast and the city of Caesarea. The first biblical figure associated with Caesarea was Philip, who shared the gospel in Caesarea after a "great persecution" expelled many believers from Jerusalem (Acts 8:1, 40). Paul traveled through Caesarea several times early in his ministry. When his life was threatened in Jerusalem, the believers in Caesarea helped him escape to Tarsus, undoubtedly aboard a Caesarean ship. After his second missionary journey, Paul passed through Caesarea on his way to Syrian Antioch, using his time in Caesarea as an opportunity to visit Jerusalem, about 52 miles away. Caesarea was built by Herod and he had his palace here in this once-thriving city. It now lies in ruins under the sea but you will be able to see its remaining foundations.

The hippodrome here was uncovered by the ocean several years ago so the area is vast. There is also a large amphitheater overlooking the ocean, built to seat thousands of people.

Before making our way to Bethlehem we will stop at the 2,000-year-old aqueduct, also built by Herod. It was so well made it is still standing today.

21 November

Day 9: Mt of Olives II Dominus Flevit II Gethsemane II Shepherds Field II Church of Nativity

This morning will we will drive through the busy narrow streets of Jerusalem to the Mount of Olives. From here we will see the panorama view of Jerusalem. Jesus himself walked here, especially when visiting Bethany, and would have seen this view many times. We will follow His path and walk down the steep Palm Sunday Road to Dominus Flevit where He famously wept over Jerusalem. He was rejected even though He healed them, feed them, and taught them. The city refused to accept Him as Messiah. Further along, we stop at the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. This is where His Passion began, as He prayed, He sweat drops of blood, in agony of what was soon to follow. His death and resurrection are what bring us here, without it we have no hope and are lost. Yet, we come to be closer to Him, to see where he walked, talked, and healed the lost. It is here you may have that unexpected encounter as you allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you.

22 November

Day 10: St Peter-in-Gallicantu II Upper Room II Davidson Centre II Holy Sepulcher II Cardo

It is a full day, today. We begin at St Peter-in-Gallicantu, built on the ruins of Caiaphas' Palace, where Jesus was tried and possibly held in the dungeon overnight. Caiaphas accused Jesus of blasphemy, which led to His death sentence by crucifixion soon after. It is also here that Peter denied Jesus three times. We will visit the Upper Room area on Mt Zion just outside the Old City walls and Zion Gate. We will wander the alleyways of the Old City and pick up some lunch from a local bakery.

From here, we go to the the Holy Sepulchre where some believe the death and burial of Jesus took place. We will also see the Old City streets of the Cardo, which is now located in the Jewish Quarter. Finally, the Davidson Centre will reveal displays from the first and second temple periods, the temple staircase, ritual baths, and shop alleyways; it's a window into ancient times.

After dinner, we will get to enjoy the Sound & Light Show in the Old City, conditions permitting.

Overnight Caesar Hotel Jerusalem | Included Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

23 November

Day 11: Temple Mount II Western Wall II Temple Tunnels II Garden Tomb

Today will take us to the Temple Mount where the temples of Solomon and Herod once stood. Only the platform remains now, which houses the Dome of the Rock. We will have the opportunity to pray at the Western Wall and maybe place a written prayer in the cracks between the rocks. We will also explore the Western Wall Tunnels that take us 400 meters below the bedrock of Jerusalem.

A must-visit is the Garden Tomb where we will share communion and view an ancient grave which some say is where Jesus was buried. The rest of your day is free to explore the Old City or enjoy the cafe life of West Jerusalem.

24 November

Day 12: David's City II Hezekiah's Tunnel II Pool of Siloam

Today is our final day in Israel and we will make our way to David's City with a movie depicting life in the time of King David and the conquering of Jerusalem. We will have the opportunity to walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel, an unforgettable experience! Awaiting us, at the end of the tunnel, is the Pool of Siloam - the site where Jesus healed the blind man (John 9:7).

The rest of the day is free until we head to Tel Aviv Airport for your flight home.

Overnight: Flight. Included Meals: Breakfast

NOTE: It is important that return flights are booked for later in the evening as there is only one transfer to the airport for the group. If your flight differs then you will be able to take the train directly to the airport for an extra cost of about USD \$6. We will endeavor to help you with all travel arrangements to and from the airport.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS: Please read the following carefully before booking. Your signature on the booking form constitutes your full acceptance of these 'Terms and Conditions.'

GENERAL: For the purposes of these booking terms and conditions the following definitions will apply: 'we/ us/our' is Teach All Nations Inc, the tour organiser; 'you/your' is the person who has signed the booking form, 'participant' is any person (including children) who forms part of the tour group.

BOOKING, DEPOSIT & FINAL PAYMENT: In order to secure a place on the Alpha Tour 2024 each participant aged 10 or over must fill out their own booking form, even if they are traveling as a couple or family (underage children can be included on a parent's form). The signed booking form(s) should be sent together with a non-refundable deposit of **USD \$400 per person.** The booking cannot be considered definite until you have received a confirmation email/letter. The balance of payment must be sent no later than **October, 20 2023** to the office. We reserve the right to cancel your booking and apply a cancellation fee if the balance is not paid by the due date. If your money is sent to a third party (e.g. church office), it is the responsibility of that party until the time it is received by the tour organiser's office. We will not be liable for the money until we receive a confirmed balance in our account.

EXCHANGE RATES: The cost of the tour is based on United States Dollars (USD). If you pay for the tour in your own national currency, please bear in mind that the final price will be based on the USD exchange rate at the time that we make the final payment to the local travel agent - GEMM - which is not the same date as your final payment to us (Teach All Nations Inc). Should the exchange rate change by more than 2% from the time of your final payment to us and our final payment to GEMM Travel, you may be asked to pay a currency supplement charge. You can avoid any exchange rate surprises by making your final payment in USD.

SINGLE-SUPPLEMENT CHARGE: The tour land arrangements are based on 'twin share' (two people sharing one hotel room). If you are traveling alone and want a single room, a 'single-supplement' extra charge must be paid. If you are traveling alone and are willing to 'twin-share' with a fellow traveler please indicate this on the booking form and we will make every effort to identify a suitable partner. However, if no partner can be found, the 'single-supplement' charge will still apply.

GROUP TOUR: The costs of the land arrangements are **based on 30 people** traveling together unless specified otherwise. Should less than this number sign up for the tour, we reserve the right to adjust the price, cancel the tour or give a refund. We will notify you two months in advance in the unlikely event of a cancellation.

ITINERARY: We plan to follow the advertised day-to-day itinerary as closely as possible, but we reserve the right to alter the itinerary at our sole discretion, for the purpose of serving the overall welfare of all the pilgrims on the tour, or if local conditions or circumstances mean that it is not possible or advisable to visit some of the advertised locations, or we deem that there is a better alternative.

FITNESS: We welcome participants of all ages but, whatever your age, you will require a reasonable level of fitness as a number of locations involve walking on rough ground, and exploring Jerusalem means climbing many sets of steps. If you are physically impaired you must have a caregiver traveling with you to assist you at all times.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TRAVEL INSURANCE: You are strongly advised to obtain travel insurance at the time you pay your deposit. Your policy should include, but not be limited to, cancellation, loss of deposit, loss of baggage, medical expenses, covid coverage, costs of repatriation to your home country if the tour is cut short or extended due to illness, or costs of returning to home country outside the tour due to the serious illness or death of a loved one. Please note that the Revival Tour 2024, Teach All Nations Inc. (Australia, United Kingdom, United States), and GEMM International Tours & Travel will not be not responsible for the expenses of uninsured travellers.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: All travel and accommodation are provided to tour participants by reputable third parties through GEMM International Tours & Travel, therefore it is important to remember that your place on the tour is subject to the liabilities and limitations imposed by these third parties.

TRANSFERS: The tour price includes one main group transfer at the beginning of the tour from the airport and also one at the end of the tour to the border and/or the airport. You must plan your own arrival and departure to coincide with the time periods we will give you. Should your flight or other travel arrangements be outside the arrival or departure time periods we give you, you will be liable to pay your own additional transfer costs. We will not make any pro-rata refund if you do not avail yourself of the transfer facility we provide.

PHOTOGRAPHY: During the tour, we may take photographs and these may be used by us for promotion and/or educational purposes. By signing the booking form you are agreeing that in the event that your image appears in any of these photos it may be used by Teach All Nations Inc. for promotion and/or educational purposes.

CHRISTIAN PILGRIMAGE & COOPERATION: Participants in the 'Revival Tour 2024' are traveling to the Middle East as Biblical tourists/pilgrims, and the tour is open to members of the Body of Christ at large. It has a Pentecostal/Charismatic flavour. Because this is a journey to Biblical sites for the purpose of devotion and education, all participants are required at all times to honour Biblical / Christian / traditional standards of morality and ethics and to fully cooperate with the tour leaders. Certain holy sites have modesty dress standards that must be respected - the pilgrim will be informed ahead of time, though they will not be required to wear formal attire. Underage children must be under the control of their parents at all times.

CANCELLATION: Should you find it necessary to cancel your reservation, you must advise us in writing. The letter of cancellation must be signed by the person making the original booking. No cancellation will be deemed effective until the signed letter is received. Cancellation charges will be levied, depending on how much money we have spent on your reservation and how close to the departure time the cancellation is received by us. Cancellation charges can vary from 30% to 100% of the amount paid. You may be entitled to reclaim any cancellation charges we make from your insurance company, depending on your reasons for the cancellation.

REFUNDS: Refunds will not be given once the tour has commenced, nor will they be given if a part of the tour was not utilised, including those parts arranged by a third party.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS: It is your responsibility to check and fulfill the passport, visa, health, and immigration requirements applicable to your itinerary. You must check requirements for your own specific circumstances with the relevant Embassies and/or Consulates and your own doctor as applicable. Requirements do change and you must check the up-to-date position in good time before departure. Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months after the date of travel.

However, we cannot and will not accept liability of any kind for acts, defaults, omissions, by negligence, damage, loss, theft of luggage and personal injury, accident, or illness or otherwise, involving any aspect of the tour outside our control or by third parties. Furthermore, the 'Revival Tour 2024' will not accept responsibility for the following, including but not limited to: actions of airlines, local tour operators, hotel operators, coach drivers or coach companies, or any other person or company providing services for this tour. We do not accept liability in contract or in tort (actionable wrong) for injury, damage, loss, delay, additional expenses, or inconvenience caused, directly or not, whether by human error or an 'act of God' (force of nature), breakdown of equipment, strikes, theft, delay, cancellations or changes in itinerary or schedule, actions of the individual tourist, including failure to listen to instructions and warnings, or any other event beyond our control, or that cannot be stopped even by our due diligence, including but not limited to terrorism, fire, war, riots, floods, very severe weather, acts of nature, acts of government, or other authorities, accidents, or mechanical failures. Again, we stress the need for you to obtain travel insurance to protect you from the unexpected.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: The participant agrees that in no event will the tour operator and organiser (Teach All Nations) be liable for the results of the participant's use of these services, or for indirect, special, or consequential damages. Participant further agrees that in no event will the total aggregate liability of the tour operator and organiser for any claims, losses, or damages arising under this agreement whether in contract or tort, exceed the total amount paid by the participant to the tour organiser during the preceding twelve (12) month period, even if the tour operator and/or organiser has been advised of the possibility of such claim, loss, or damage except for losses arising from the tour operator's and/or organiser's gross negligence, fraud, or wilful misconduct. The foregoing limitation of liability and exclusion of certain damages shall apply regardless of the success or effectiveness of other remedies.

COMPLAINTS: While we do our very best to serve the pilgrims under our charge, we live in an imperfect world and problems may arise. Should there be an issue, here is the protocol:

- 1. If there is an issue involving the tour, you should immediately bring it to the attention of the responsible person (tour guide, team leader, tour organiser, etc.) who will try to resolve the issue on the spot.
- 2. If there is an issue with the hotel and problems with the room, you should speak to the front desk of the hotel. If you cannot get satisfaction from the hotel you should then bring it to the attention of the responsible tour person (the tour guide is the first person to ask). We will do our best to assist in resolving the issue.
- 3. In the unlikely event that an issue cannot be resolved on the spot and you need to write to us about it, you should send us your written account within twenty-eight (28) days of the completion of the tour. You can expect an initial response from us within 14-28 days after your letter is received. Any letters received more than twenty-eight days after the tour has finished will be deemed 'late' and no action will be taken or response sent.

MISCELLANEOUS: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws (excluding the law of conflict of laws) of the State of Victoria, Commonwealth of Australia. All disputes shall be resolved in Melbourne, Victoria. THIS AGREEMENT CONSTITUTES THE COMPLETE AND EXCLUSIVE STATEMENT OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES CONCERNING THE SUBJECT MATTER OF THIS AGREEMENT.
